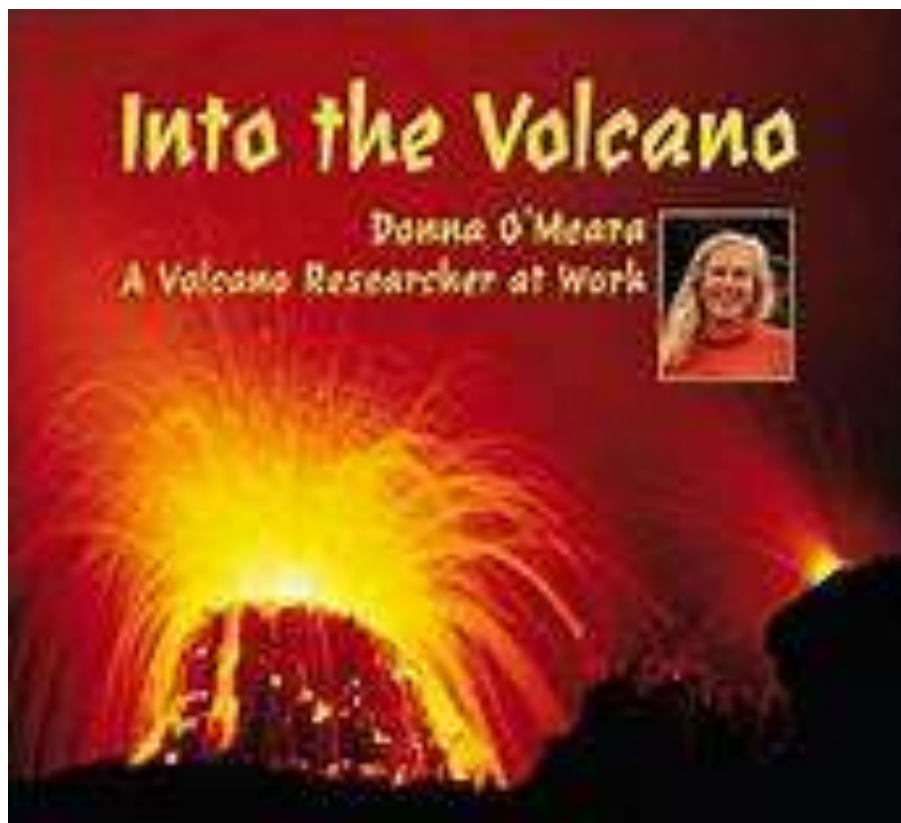

Volcano Introduction Vocabulary

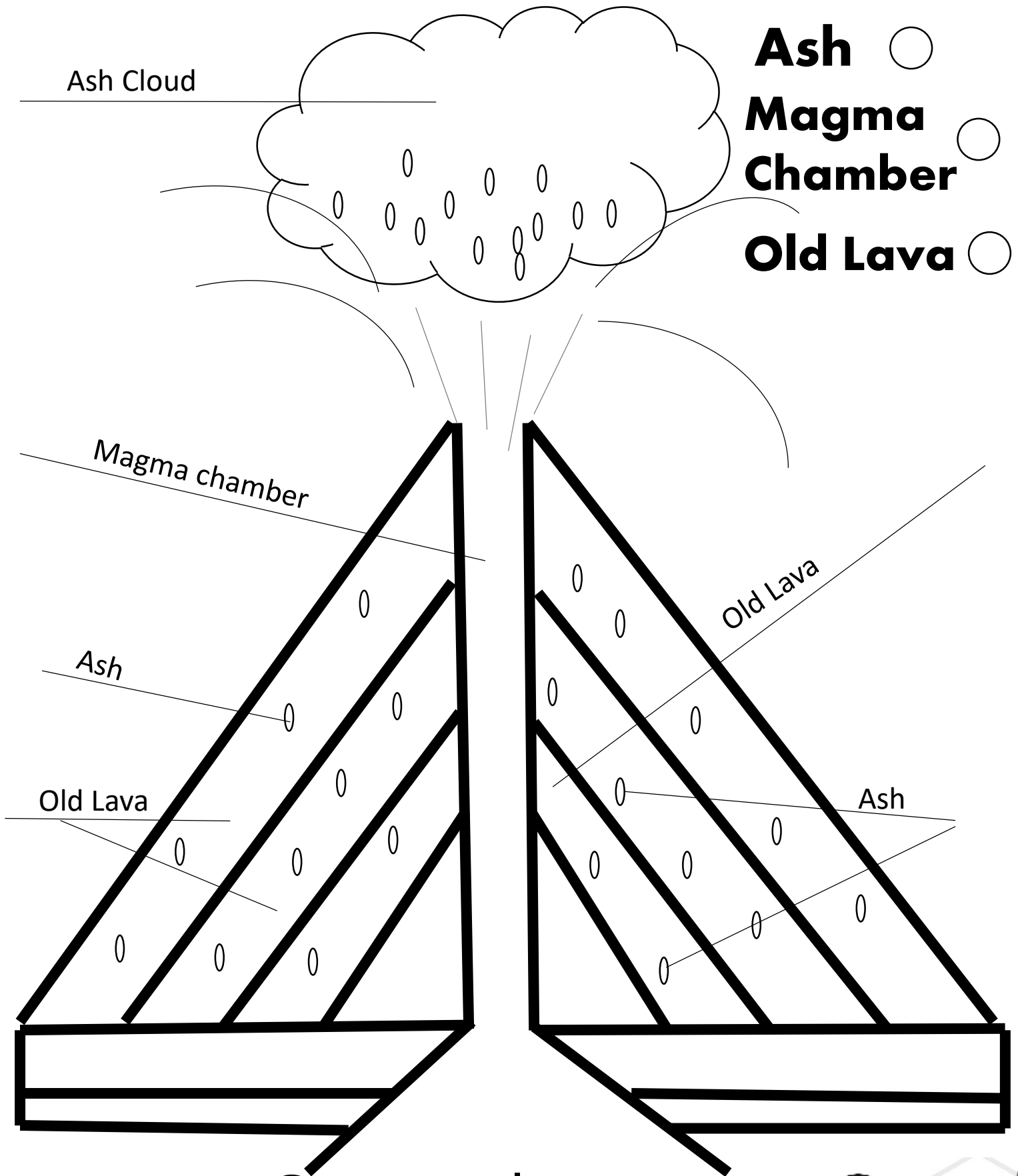
Ash: Tiny parts of a volcano that gets spit out when an eruption happens.

Magma: Melted rock that is beneath Earth's surface, that becomes lava when a volcano spits it out.

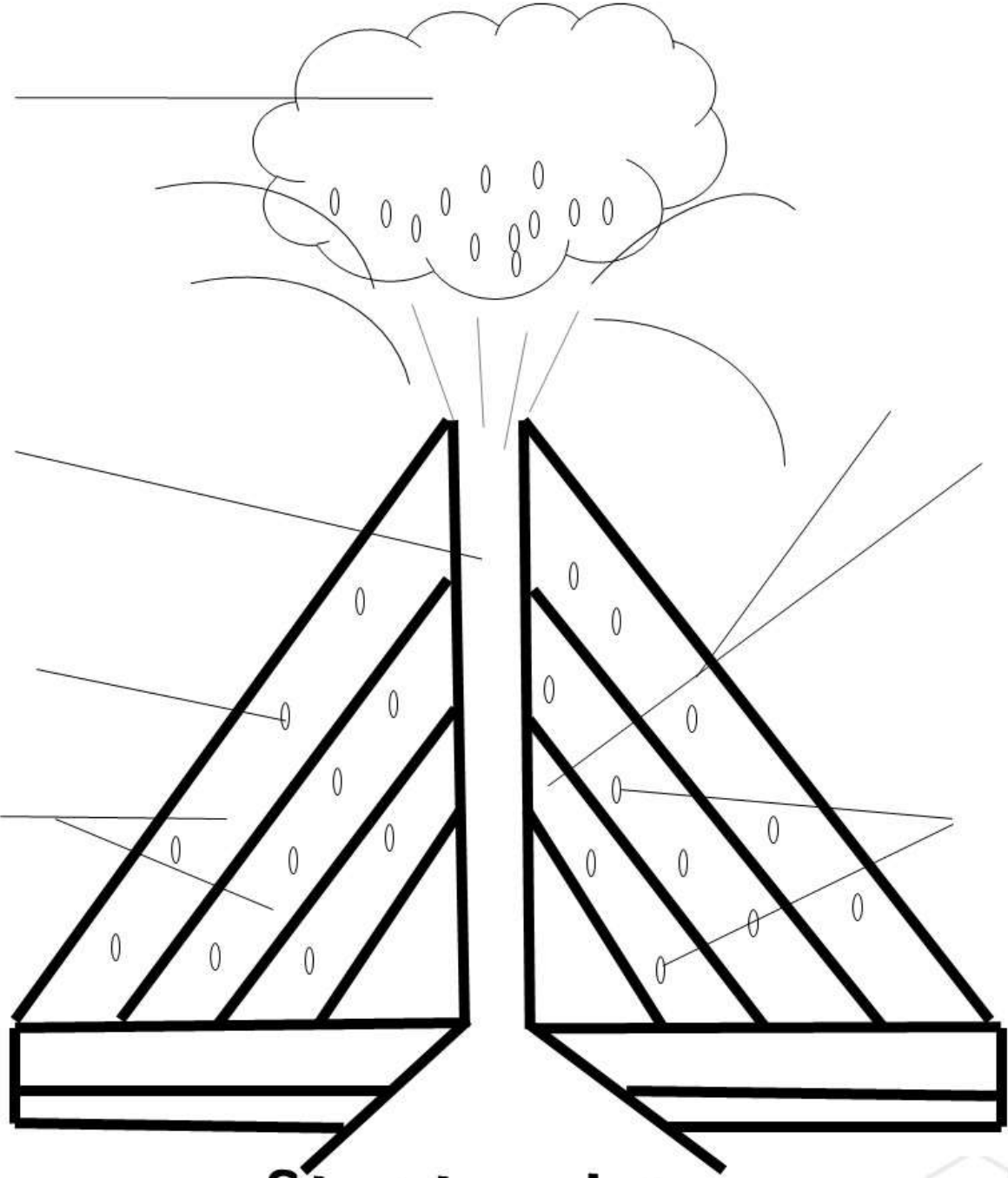
Lava: The melted rock that a volcano spits out when it erupts.

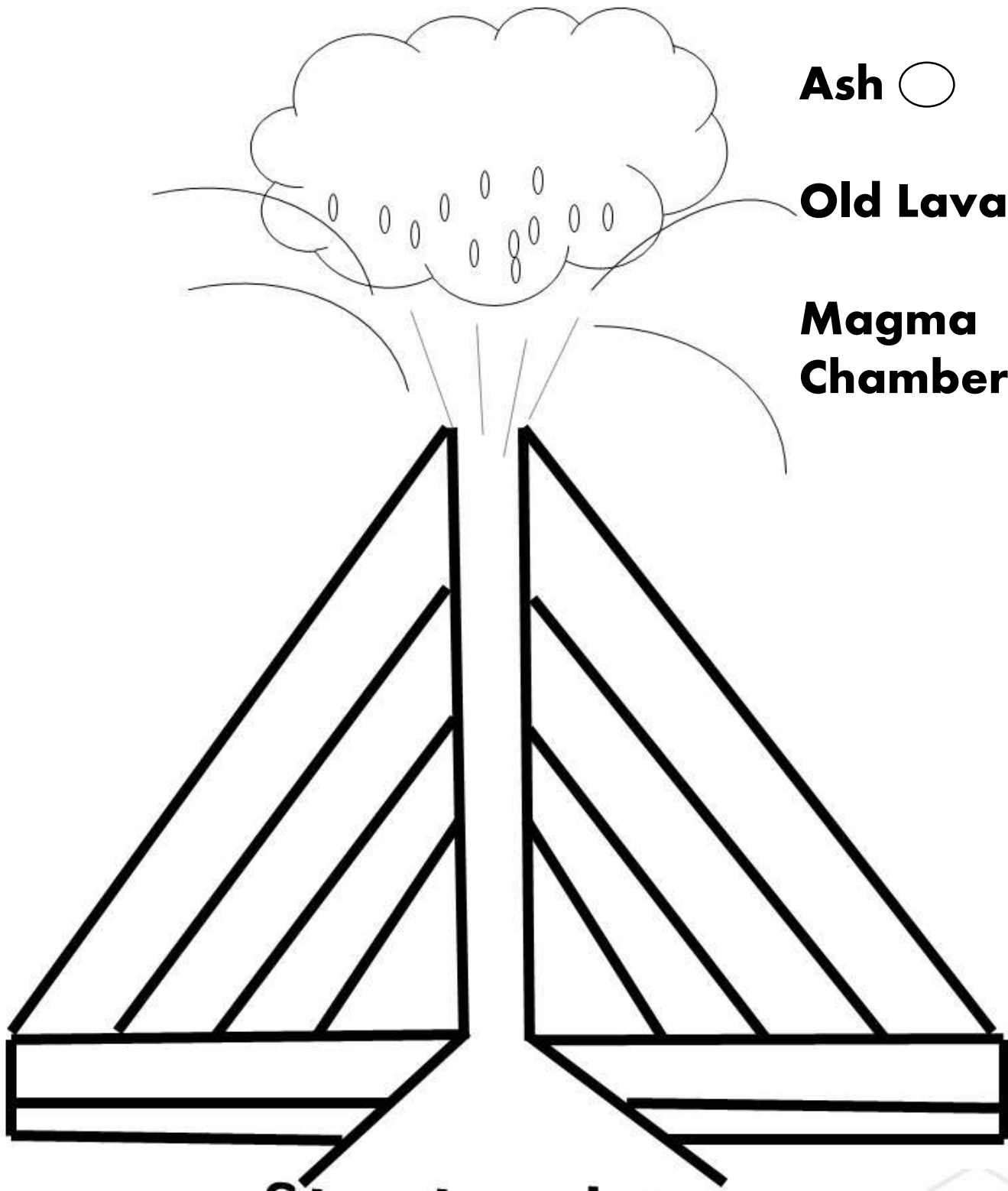
